7. Letter of support to LPPS Birdsong Path

As background, a representative from the Lighthouse Park Preservation Society (LPPS) applied for a grant to the Prince George Foundation to complete work along the Juniper accessibility trail in 2021. This application was unsuccessful and the LPPS representative is now applying to the West Vancouver Foundation Grant Program 2022 to provide two rest spots, one with a wheelchair accessible picnic table and the second with an accessible bench and to upgrade the pathway inbetween the two rest stops to be renamed to Birdsong Path upon completion. That ACDI support the Lighthouse Parks Preservation Society grant application to the West Vancouver Community Foundation (by way of a "Letter of Support").
