## 7. Accessibility Issues in Front of Council

## District of North Vancouver

As a follow up to a question raised at the February meeting with respect to the supportive housing project on West 16<sup>th</sup>, information was provided that 5% of the units will be fully accessible to wheelchairs and will follow the enhanced design criteria. A public hearing on the project will be held on Tuesday, March 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm.

## Action: Staff will forward the information to the Committee by email.

A question was raised around the new community centre off Fullerton and whether there has been a review of the accessibility needs for the community centre. Information was provided that the project was previously brought to a subcommittee of the ACDI.

A report will be going to Council with respect to the creation of new committee on climate action.

A further report will be going to Council around changing the terms of reference to allow virtual participation in committees to carry on after the pandemic. Most of the committees have been meeting virtually and this is providing an easy way to access meetings rather than coming to the Hall.

The street area in the City is being utilized for the walking safe and making it easy to maneuver in the City.

March 6 and March 21 are being declared to recognize people with Downs Syndrome.

There is a public hearing for the 63 Mahon Avenue public school project.

Open Streets subcommittee review will take place on April 8<sup>th</sup> and information will be provided to members prior to the meeting.

The Esplanade project will also be returning to the ACDI for review.

The City Parks Department are looking at improving the playground at St. Georges and 11<sup>th</sup> and whether ACDI would be interested in doing a small park audit at the end of April. Concern was raised around the comfort level around meeting in person at the park, and it was suggested whether this could be done by reviewing the plans instead of visiting the park, or that members could visit the park independently.

### District of West Vancouver

Welch Street Bridge widening project has started and have established with fencing accessibility for everyone but passageway for pedestrians is too narrow for everyone using the same area.

The Navy Jack House is being revamped and that this project should be brought to ACDI for review around accessibility.
