ADVISORY OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE (AOC) Standing Committee of Council

TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 1. A Standing Committee of Council, to be known as the District of North Vancouver Advisory Oversight Committee, is hereby established.
- 2. The mandate of the Committee shall be:
 - (a) To review the Terms of Reference for Community Committees of Council as needed and be authorized to amend such as the AOC determines:
 - (b) Create a standardized Terms of Reference for new advisory committees, taskforces, working groups or other such bodies;
 - (c)Initiate a committee policy to include forum/working groups and oversee the implement of the transition process;
 - (d) Be authorized to make recommendations for appointments to community advisory groups, task forces, working groups, or other such bodies as needed and required by the applicable Terms of Reference; and, to seek the recommendations of the appropriate staff when/where necessary. Note, Council resolution is required for any recommendations or appointments for the following committees:
 - i) Standing Advisory/Statutory Committees
 - ii) Regional Committees
- 3. The Committee shall encourage closer liaison with other granting bodies, including other municipalities, the Provincial and Federal Governments and private agencies.
- 4. The Committee shall encourage the continuation and extension of volunteer services in the District of North Vancouver.
- 5. The Committee shall consist of three members of Council
- Each member will be appointed for a one-year term or until a replacement is duly appointed.
- 7. The Chair and Vice-Chair shall be elected by the Committee at its first meeting in January every year.

- 8. A simple majority of the existing sitting members shall constitute a quorum.
- 9. All decisions of the Committee shall be determined by a simple majority vote of the members present.
- The meeting schedule will be determined by the Committee on an as needed basis.
- 11. District staff shall provide professional advice and other staff assistance to the Committee at the discretion of the Chief Administrative Officer. No staff person shall be a voting member of the Committee.
- 12. As a Standing Committee, the AOC is required to adhere to all applicable requirements of the *Community Charter*.
- 13. All points of procedure not specifically provided for in these Terms of Reference shall be decided and determined in accordance with <u>Robert's</u> Rules of Order.
- 14. There shall be no budget assigned for this committee.
