# Driveway Requirements Slope 10 DEG to 20 DEG aster Requirement ENG 103



# **Purpose**

To establish whether vehicle access to the lot is acceptable with respect to safety and drainage issues.

# **Background**

The following guidelines shall be used when considering a new driveway access to a single-family residential lot:

The Development Services Bylaw #8145 Section 5.14 will need to be reviewed by all builders / homeowners for driveway grades, location and width.

Driveway submission requirements vary with the complexity of the topography associated with the development. If the work includes a new driveway or the adjustment of an existing driveway and the driveway grade will be between 10% and 20% the information in Requirements below must be provided. This information may be combined with the *Site Plan*.
